### **Suggested guidelines to ensure everyone has a good time at functions or How mates should behave**

As the behaviour of all members of our club influences how other members enjoy functions and how new and prospective members view the club, it is inherent upon members to uphold certain standards of behaviour while at Dabblers' functions.

Club members should limit the amount of alcohol that they consume. They should never be so inebriated as to cause concern, both to others and for their wellbeing.

Dabblers should conform to standards of behaviour that are acceptable in the general community and also conforms to the Anti-Discrimination Act. These should exclude:

- excessive drinking
- boisterous behaviour
- foul language
- suggestive behaviour
- annoying other members
- ethnic, racial and sexual action or comments

#### **Children at functions**

While children are welcome at some functions, it is good manners to check with the host to see if children are permitted.

Members who bring children to functions should see that they are fully supervised at all times. This can be a problem where alcohol is a strong feature of the function.

#### **Transport**

It is up to each member to arrange transport for themselves to functions. Members may offer to transport other members, but this should never be taken as a right.

If you receive a lift it might well be appreciated to reimburse the driver in some way.
