Dabblers Social Club is completely non profit and is designed for men and women from a variety of backgrounds and ages from 18 upwards. It is not connected to any religious, political or sectarian groups.

As the behaviour of all members of our Club influences how other members enjoy functions and how new and prospective members view the Club, it is inherent upon members to uphold certain standards of behaviour whilst at any Dabblers' function.

Members **are expected** to conform to the standards of behaviour that are acceptable in the general community.

Functions

Members **please** ensure that you RSVP to the function host by the advertised date.

Members **please** avoid just turning up to a function without advice to the function host. You may or will be turned away, especially if maximum numbers have been reached. So the best way is to book ahead.

If you are unable to attend a function you have booked in for, **please** ensure you advise your host immediately. Sometimes there may be a waiting list and this will enable an alternate member to join the function.

If you are hosting a function and for reasons beyond your control are unable to proceed, it is advisable that you **do not cancel the function unless absolutely necessary**. Please attempt to find an alternate host.

Transport

It is up to each member to arrange transport for themselves to functions.

Members may offer to transport other members, but this must never be taken as a right.

If you receive a lift it might be appreciated to reimburse the driver in some way.

Children at functions

Whilst children are welcome at some functions, it is good manners to check with the host to ensure it is appropriate for attendance by children.

Members who bring children to functions should see that they are fully supervised at all times.
